2026 PRISON CRUSADE—CFRC

Since 2022, DREAM has had the honor of joining The Encounter on powerful prison crusades—and in 2026, we're doing it again. The Encounter has been faithfully serving incarcerated men and women for over 45 years, reaching facilities all across the state of Florida and helping countless lives both inside and outside the wire.

DREAM is humbled to stand alongside this ministry. Pastor Kory serves as a platform speaker, boldly preaching the Gospel, while his wife Kasey leads worship and ushers in the presence of God. Recently, The Encounter received approval to bring a camera into places very few ever get to see, allowing us to document the incredible things God is doing behind the walls.

To the right, you'll see Pastor Kory preaching to hundreds of men at CFRC in Orlando—a major reception center where many inmates take their first steps before heading to their permanent camps. In one of the darkest seasons of their lives, we get to bring the message of hope: they weren't just arrested... this is actually their rescued.

5 YEARS OF BUILDING THE KINGDOM

In 2020, while pastoring a small church in Eastpoint, Florida, God gave Pastor Kory a vision and spoke clearly to his heart: "I have given you everything to start your ministry." From that moment, Kory hit the ground running. In the early days, he brought men straight out of prison into his own home, letting them sleep on the couch until he could find a place for them—and God always provided.

Soon after, Kory stepped down from pastoring to pursue the vision full-time, not knowing what the future held, but trusting that with God, it would be good. In 2021, DREAM purchased its first men's home and officially became a 501(c)(3). That means January 1, 2026 marks our five-year anniversary.

Since then, God has expanded the ministry in ways we never imagined. He called DREAM to the greater Tampa area, where we sold the original men's home and opened three new ones. God also reminded Kory early on that "ministry will not look in the end like it did in the beginning." And He was right—things have been shifting. Today, DREAM is traveling into prisons across Alabama, Indiana, Florida, and soon Texas—with hopes of going international. God is opening doors that we always dreamed of.

As we celebrate five incredible years of building the Kingdom of God, one thing has remained constant: God has been faithful.



GODCASTS

Revelation 12:11 declares, "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony..." This is exactly what Pastor Kory has been called to do. Everywhere he goes, he shares the story of how God pulled him out of the darkness of addiction and crime and brought him into a life overflowing with love, light, and restoration.

This past February, Kory was featured on two powerful "Godcasts"—Worthy People based in San Antonio, Texas, and Delefe Testimonies, which traveled from Delaware to Orlando to record his interview. These Godcasts dive deep into real-life stories of transformation, and Kory's testimony did not disappoint. Once released, the episode was uploaded to the Pando app and streamed directly to tablets inside correctional facilities. Within just a few days, it reached over 300,000 views. Inmates all across the United States are hearing the hope of Jesus through this Godcast.

BADGED IN INDY PRISONS

In the first week of March, Pastor Kory and his wife Kasey flew to Indianapolis, Indiana, where they completed the volunteer training required to become officially badged with IDOC. This marks another major step forward for DREAM. We have already ministered inside two Indiana prisons, and now we are fully equipped and approved to visit even more. DREAM plans to schedule two trips a year to Indiana, not only to enter state prisons but also to minister in several county jails. The doors God is opening in this region are incredible, and we are honored to carry the hope of Jesus wherever He sends us
